EMERGENCY SHELTER WHERE DID YOU SLEEP LAST NIGHT?

If you are unsure where you and your family are staying tonight, OCCAC may offer temporary emergency sheltering.

Emergency Motel Vouchers

May be provided if individuals / families meet eligibility requirements pending motel vacancies and funding availability.

Tents / Sleeping Bags

Available to homeless individuals while supplies last.

Personal Hygiene Supplies

RENTAL ASSISTANCE DO YOU NEED HELP WITH YOUR HOUSING?

Do you have an eviction or late notice from your landlord? If so, call our office to talk about your options.

Eviction Prevention:

We may be able to assist your household if you received an eviction notice due to non-payment.

Move in Costs:

First month's rent and deposit assistance for families transitioning from homelessness to stable housing.

Miscellaneous Services:

One-time gas / food/ clothing vouchers, utility assistance, and more.
